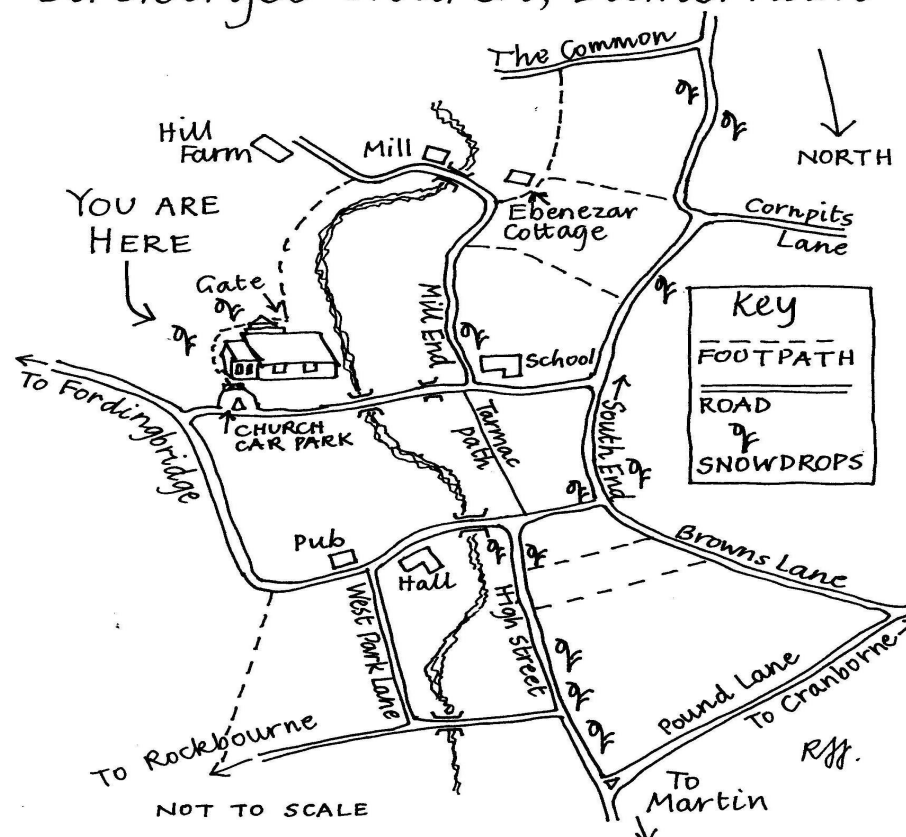
of Snowdrop Sunday of St. George's Church, Damerham

If you have energy to spare after admiring the snowdrops in the churchyard, you could:

1. turn left out of the church car park and walk down to the school. (Look out for egrets by the river.) Turn left towards Mill End: from the roadway in about 50 yards you can see a display of snowdrops in a private woodland garden. Return to the church (15-30 minutes).

OR 2. walk down towards the school and turn right through a wooden gate on to a tarmac path. At the far end turn left on the road and continue turning left 'round the block' back to the school, looking for the snowdrops in the verges. Return to the church (30-45 minutes).

OR 3. (if you have sturdy shoes on!) from the churchyard take the footpath leading through the kissing-gate opposite the church porch. At the metalled roadway keep straight on down past the mill. You can continue along the road back to the school, or at Ebenezar Cottage you can turn left on to the public footpath. Keep straight on across to The Commons, turning right when you reach the roadway, and right again at the junction. Notice the bank of snowdrops on your right by the telegraph pole. After about half a mile you can take Steels Lane on your right back to the school and up to the church, or you can continue straight on to the junction by Greenbank Farmhouse, and turn right there. In about 50 yards either take the tarmac footpath on your right back to the school and church, or turn left up the High Street, noting the snowdrops in the little wood behind the telephone box. Continue up the High Street to the Rockbourne turning on your right. Go down here and cross Littlemill bridge, turning right into West Park Lane. At the bottom turn right again, pass the village hall and cross the Allen River. Just past Crossways Farm take the tarmac footpath back to the school and return to the church.
